

THE ICONIC SPORT Challenge 2020

Terms and Conditions

Authorised under NSW Permit No LTPS/20/42780, ACT Permit No TP 20/00393, SA Permit No T20/348

1. The promoter is Internet Services Australia 1 Pty Limited ("THE ICONIC") of Level 18, 338 Pitt St, Sydney, NSW 2000, ACN 152 631 082.
2. Information on how to enter forms part of the terms of entry. Entry into the competition is deemed acceptance of these terms and conditions.
3. Each challenge is a game of chance. A winner who has met the selection criteria (completed the required physical activity) will be selected at random via a computer-generated draw.
4. Entry is open to all residents of Australia and New Zealand who are 18 years of age or over (as set out further below). However, employees of Sport Heroes Australia or THE ICONIC and their associated agencies and companies are not eligible to win.
5. The challenge competition period is from Tuesday, 10 March 2020 12:00am (AEDT) to Tuesday 5 May 2020 at 23:59pm (AEST) ("Promotional Period").
6. To enter challenges and be eligible to win prizes, participants must enrol in THE ICONIC SPORT Challenge – at www.theiconicsportchallenge.com, app.theiconicsportchallenge.com or download THE ICONIC SPORT App on Apple Store or Google Play – complete the challenge exercise requirements (example run 1 x 5km), track the exercise with the relevant GPS tracking app and visit THE ICONIC SPORT App or www.theiconicsportchallenge.com to sync their activity. When a participant enters a challenge they are automatically in the running to win a brand voucher for that particular challenge.
7. Each specific brand prize detailed in the table at clause 11 below will only be available to win on one particular day during the Promotional Period.
8. Some brand vouchers cannot be won by New Zealand residents. All entrants should read the full terms and conditions for a particular challenge before entering.
9. The random prize draws commence on Wednesday, 11 March 2020 and end on Wednesday 6 May 2020 and will take place every day at 10:00 at 223 Liverpool St, Darlinghurst. Prizes are vouchers of varying amounts, to be redeemed on different brands via THE ICONIC website. Each winner will win one voucher. The 'you've won' messaging will be delivered as both a pop up on THE ICONIC SPORT App or www.theiconicsportchallenge.com and winners will be emailed within 7 days of receiving this notification via an auto generated email in a participant's inbox.

12. All prizes will be issued as vouchers to redeem on <https://www.theiconic.com.au/sports-all/> and delivered digitally, via email. The vouchers cannot be redeemed with any other offer. Prize winners will receive an email confirming their prize win and will be prompted to fill in their contact details in a digital form. Prize winners will receive an email with their unique voucher code within 48 hours of filling in their contact details in the digital form. Each voucher may only be used to *purchase relevant sport items* from the brand each individual challenge is associated with (e.g. Nike's voucher can only be used on Nike sport performance products, not on Nike lifestyle products). The entire voucher amount must be redeemed in one transaction. Winners may make additional purchases within this transaction, above and beyond the value of their prize voucher, at their personal expense. Each prize voucher of more than \$50 comes with free shipping. All prize vouchers are valid until Thursday, 5 November 2020 after which point any unused vouchers will expire. 13. Entrants may only enter one challenge at a time and cannot win any single challenge more than once, nor complete any single challenge more than once. In the event an entrant wins any single challenge more than once, due to a bug, technical issue, or for any other reason, the entrant must forfeit any prize won after their initial prize.
14. The Promoter reserves the right to request winners to provide proof of identity, proof of residency at the nominated prize delivery address and/or proof of entry validity (including phone bill or store receipt for purchase requirement) in order to claim a prize. Proof of identification, residency, and entry considered suitable for verification is at the discretion of the Promoter. In the event that a

winner cannot provide suitable proof, the winner will forfeit the prize in whole and no substitute will be offered.

15. The Promoter reserves the right to verify the validity of entries and to disqualify any entry which, in the opinion of Promoter, includes objectionable content, profanity, potentially insulting, inflammatory or defamatory statements, disqualify any entrant who tampers with the entry process, who submits an entry that is not in accordance with these Terms & Conditions of Entry or who has, in the opinion of Promoter, engaged in conduct in entering the Promotion which is fraudulent, misleading, deceptive or generally damaging to the goodwill or reputation of the Promotion and/or Promoter. The Promoter reserves the right to disqualify a winner if the Promoter becomes aware that the winner and/or the winner's entry is of a type described in this clause.
16. Prizes cannot be transferred and cannot be redeemed for cash.
17. Unless expressly stated, all costs and expenses associated with taking the Prize are the responsibility of the prize winner.
18. Unless expressly stated in these terms and conditions all other expenses become the responsibility of the winner.
19. If the prize is unavailable, for whatever reason, the Promoter reserves the right to substitute the prize for a prize of equal or greater value.
20. The promoter reserves the right to refuse to allow a winner to take part in any or all aspects of the prize, if the promoter determines, in their absolute discretion, that a winner is not in the mental or physical condition necessary to be able to safely participate in the prize. It is a condition of accepting the prize that the winner may be required to sign a legal release in a form determined by the promoter in its absolute discretion.
21. Once prizes have left the Promoter's premises, the Promoter takes no responsibility for prizes damaged, delayed or lost in transit.
22. In the event that for any reason whatsoever a winner does not take an element of the prize at the time stipulated by the Promoter then that element of the prize will be forfeited by the winner and cash will not be awarded in lieu of that element of the prize.
23. Prize values are based upon the recommended retail prices at the time of printing (inclusive of GST). The promoter accepts no responsibility for change in prize value between now and the ultimate prize redemption date.
24. The judge's decision is final and the promoter will not enter into correspondence regarding the Competition result.
25. Prizes will be awarded to the person named in the entry. However, in a dispute, the prize will be awarded to the account holder of the entry mechanism used to submit their entry (i.e. mobile phone account holder or land line account holder).
26. Should an entrant's contact details change during the promotional period, it is the entrant's responsibility to notify the Promoter. A request to access or modify any information provided in an entry should be directed to the Promoter.
27. Winners will be notified by email within seven working days of the respective draw. All reasonable attempts will be made to contact the Winner. If a prize remains unclaimed by a winner or unallocated or forfeited for any reason at the end of the Promotional Period, the prize will be redrawn on Wednesday 5 August 2020, at the same time and location as the original draw, excluding the entrant that has failed to claim the prize. If the secondary prize remains unclaimed after a redraw, no further redraws will take place.

In the case of the intervention of any outside act, agent or event which prevents or significantly hinders the Promoter's ability to proceed with the competition on the dates and in the manner described in these terms and conditions, including but not limited to vandalism, power failures, tempests, natural disasters, acts of God, civil unrest, strike, war, act of terrorism, the Promoter may in its absolute discretion cancel the competition and recommence it from the start on the same conditions, subject to approval by relevant state authorities.

The Promoter and the prize supplier shall not be liable for any loss or damage whatsoever that is suffered (including but not limited to indirect or consequential loss) or for any personal injury suffered or sustained in connection with any prize/s except for any liability which cannot be excluded by law. The Promoter and the prize supplier are not responsible for any incorrect or inaccurate information, either caused by the user or for any of the equipment or programming associated with or utilised in this competition, or for any technical error, or any combination thereof that may occur in the course of the administration of this competition including any omission, interruption, deletion, defect, delay in operation or transmission, communications line or telephone, mobile or satellite network failure, theft or destruction or unauthorised access to or alteration of entries.
32. The Promoter reserves the right in its sole discretion to disqualify any individual who the Promoter has reason to believe has breached any of these conditions or engaged in any unlawful or other improper misconduct calculated to jeopardise the fair and proper conduct of the promotion. The Promoter's legal rights to recover damages or other compensation from such an offender are reserved.
33. THE ICONIC, Sport Heroes Australia, and their associated agencies and companies and the prize supplier assume no responsibility for any error, omission, interruption, deletion, defect, delay in operation or transmission, communications line failure, theft or destruction or unauthorised access to, or alteration of entries, and reserves the right to take any action that may be available.
34. If for any reason this competition is not capable of running as planned, including due to infection by computer virus, bugs, tampering, unauthorised intervention, fraud, technical failures or any causes beyond the control of the Promoter, which corrupt or affect the administration, security, fairness or integrity or proper conduct of this promotion, the Promoter reserves the right in its sole discretion to disqualify any individual who tampers with the entry process, take any action that may be available, and to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the competition.
